MAIN GOAL

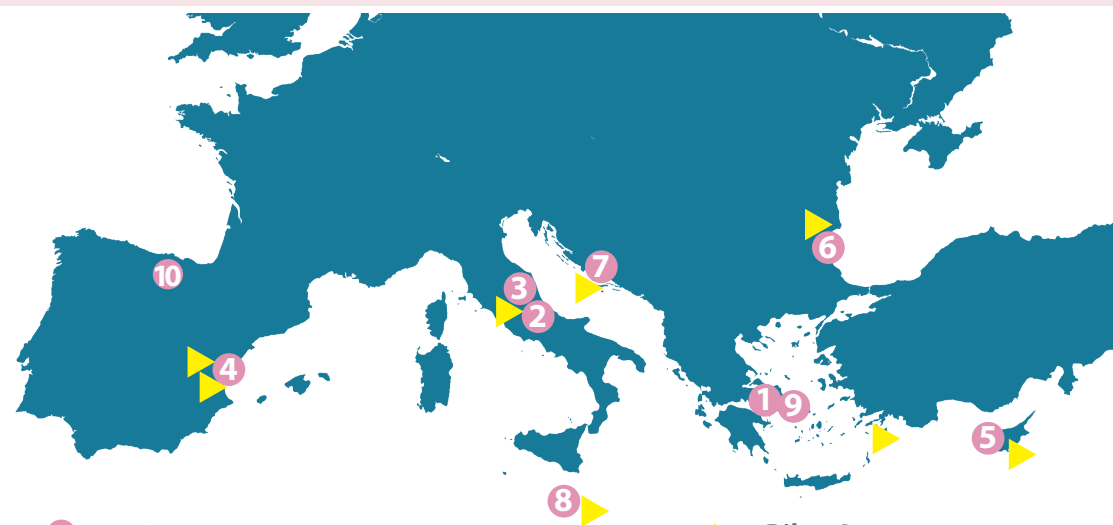
TOURISMO addresses persistent Mediterranean tourism challenges, such as overtourism, by leveraging innovative technologies to monitor and manage tourist flows.
